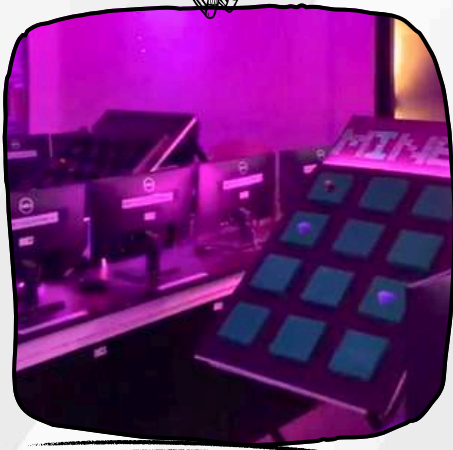
Stake Arcade

Upward Trial

Team-based version of "Upward Trails" (a game similar to Snakes and Ladders), two players form a team. 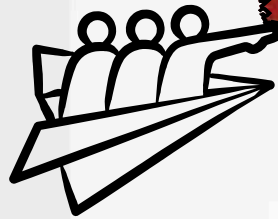
Students spoke about the good and bad sides of both cultures. They shared their thoughts with confidence and clear ideas.

GNFC Training @ Bharuch

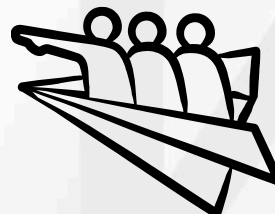

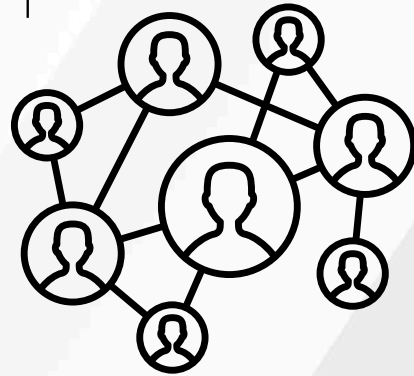
Google Education Leader-Series-2025
