CAMPUS ENTRY GUIDELINES & CODE OF CONDUCT

(NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS & VISITORS)

All students and visitors of University are hereby informed to follow campus entry guidelines and code conduct. Entry onto this campus implies unconditional agreement to comply with the University Student Code of Conduct. Non-compliance will result in immediate denial of entry or strict disciplinary action.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON CAMPUS

- **Ragging / Hazing:** The University maintains a **zero-tolerance** policy. Any act of ragging is a criminal offense under the law and will result in immediate expulsion and a police report (FIR).
- **Substance Abuse:** This is a **Dry and Drug-Free Campus**. Possession, consumption, or being under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, tobacco, or e-cigarettes/vapes is strictly banned.
- **Weapons & Violence:** Carrying firearms, explosives, knives, or any object intended as a weapon is forbidden. Physical altercations or threats will lead to instant suspension.

MANDATORY ENTRY & PARKING REQUISITES

Mandatory Requirement	Rules and Compliance	Enforcement Action
Identity Proof	University ID Card must be worn and clearly visible at all times while on campus premises.	Entry denied without valid ID.
Security Screening	All vehicles, bags, and personal belongings are subject to security checks at the gate.	Refusal will result in immediate denial of entry.
Authorized Parking	All vehicles must display a valid ID Card issued by University and be parked <i>only</i> in designated Student Parking Zones.	Double-parking, blocking roads, or parking in Faculty/Visitor slots will result in immediate wheel-clamping and a heavy fine.





Established under Gujarat Private University Act, 2009 and Recognised by UGC under Section 2(f)

Speed Limit & Safety	Maximum speed limit on campus is 10km/h . Helmets are mandatory for two-wheelers (both rider and pillion).	Persistent reckless driving or failure to wear a helmet will result in vehicle entry revocation.
Visitor Protocol	External guests must register at the gate, state their purpose, and obtain a visitor pass.	Unauthorized guests will be treated as trespassers.
